The Rocks is in close proximity to nearly 200 golf courses in and around Scottsdale. Owners and guests at The Rocks enjoy preferred access to local Troon courses, among the finest in the game.

Outdoor Recreation

There are abundant opportunities for hiking, biking, hot air ballooning, tennis, horseback riding, water parks, river tubing, guided day trips and more.

Cultural Attractions

Scottsdale offers countless cultural attractions. Transportation

The Rocks Luxury Residence Club is extremely accessible, making it the perfect place to escape to anytime. The most convenient airport is Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport (PHX), where there are direct flights from countless major U.S. cities served by most major airlines including American, Continental, Delta, Frontier,

Northwest, and United. Please contact the Concierge, as the airport is approximately 45 minutes away from The Rocks.

We recommend that you rent a car during your stay at The Rocks. The Concierge can help facilitate. For taxi service, please contact the Concierge.

Notes of Distinction

- No transfer/transportation is included – you will want a vehicle while there and your concierge will be happy to arrange a rental for you.
- Limited dining – Complimentary Continental Breakfast is served daily 6:30am-11:00am. Additional hot breakfast menu items are also available for a nominal charge. Full lunch menu service is also provided daily from 12Noon to 3pm. Items from both the breakfast & lunch menu can be delivered to your villa -ie: "room service". Additional arrangements may also be made - in advance - for chef prepared in-villa dining or a pre-prepared BBQ package.
- Light housekeeping is included – beds made daily, linen change mid-week (\$280 is for a three bedroom villa and \$350 is for a four bedroom villa). The Guest is billed for housekeeping fees at the end of the stay.
- Fitness facility with pool and spa treatment rooms as well as lounge & billiards room.
- There are some natural wildlife features to consider – rattlesnakes, cacti, scorpion, etc.
- The Rocks is a non-smoking/non-pet community.

General Information

- Landscape: Those traveling with children should note that cactus and wildlife abound right outside the villa doors. The landscape can be rough; scorpions, snakes and stinging plants are all present.
- Taxes: Local sales tax is 7.95%
- Tipping: Tipping is permitted on The Rocks property if you are inclined to reward a staff member for exemplary service. The industry standard for tipping at restaurants in the area is 15-20%.
- Weather: Scottsdale's climate is arid and warm, with sunny days virtually all year. In fact, with fewer than 8 inches (20 centimeters) of rainfall per year, Scottsdale consistently ranks as the "Sunniest City" in the United States. The intense, clear Arizona skies give the feeling of being able to see forever.
