Snowmass Nightlife

During the summer, Jazz Aspen Snowmass hosts a Thursday night concert series with free music on the slopes. Afterward, the bars welcome concertgoers to continue celebrating in the village.

Aspen Nightlife

Year-round, Aspen offers an array of nighttime entertainment options. For live music, head to the Belly Up; for DJ dancing, try Club Chelsea, the Lava Room or Syzygy on Sunday nights. Après-ski venues range from the super chic setting of The Little Nell lounge to the more relaxed atmosphere of Mezzaluna.

Special Events

Aspen/Snowmass plays host to events throughout the year, from ESPN's Winter X Games in late January to the Food & Wine Magazine Classic in June to the Jazz Aspen Snowmass Labor Day Festival. Transportation

There are many options for traveling to and from The Timbers Club throughout the year. The Aspen/Pitkin County Airport (ASE) is just 7 miles from The Timbers Club, and features service from Delta, USAir, Frontier and United Airlines. The airport also handles private flights. The Timbers Club offers complimentary shuttle service to and from Aspen/Pitkin County Airport.

You may also choose to fly into another nearby airport and enjoy a gorgeous drive through beautiful Colorado. Eagle County Airport (EGE) is 90 minutes away, and Grand Junction Airport (GJT) is 2 hours by car. Denver International Airport (DEN) is 4 hours away, and can be reached through hassle-free shuttle service from Colorado Mountain Express by calling 800.525.6363 or visiting www.ridecme.com.

During your stay, Jeep, SUV and car rentals may be arranged through the Concierge. For taxi service, please call 970.925.TAXI or contact the Concierge to arrange.

General Information

- Banks & ATMs: Alpine Bank is located at the Snowmass Center across the street from The Timbers Club. An Alpine Bank ATM can be found on the main level of the Snowmass Village Mall.
- Taxes: Local sales tax is 2.2% in Aspen, 9.9% in Snowmass. The state sales tax is 2.9%.
- Tipping: Tipping is not permitted on The Timbers Club property, as our Owner fees cover this expense. The industry standard for tipping at restaurants in the area is 15-20%.
- Weather: Colorado is well known for its annual supply of 300 days of sunshine and temperate mountain climate. For current weather information and the forecast, visit www.weather.com.

Notes of Distinction

- Airport transfers are included. Point-to-point transportation is scheduled in advance and is on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- No restaurant on site, private chef or in-room dining service available (great restaurants in the Aspen/Snowmass area).
- No daily housekeeping fee. Daily trash & towel service is provided, though beds are not made. A weekly housekeeping fee of \$220 is charged to the guest at the end of their stay. Additional housekeeping is available by request and will be charged at an hourly rate of \$40/hour.
- Fitness facility with pool and yoga center.
- No full-service Spa. One common treatment room is available or in-room massages can be arranged.
- The Timbers Club is at a very high altitude – 8100 feet. Be sure to drink plenty of water during your stay to avoid altitude sickness.
- Dogs are allowed in a pet-specific villa at the Timbers Club. Please ask your concierge about reserving this residence.
